You can choose to attend any ADA diabetes camp, but the maximum you can earn is limited to the camp fee, less any deposit paid by you. COMMIT-TED will make payment to the American Diabetes Association only. No refunds will be returned if you do not attend camp for any reason.

This is what you need to do:

1. **IMPORTANT!** Send in a deposit to the ADA to reserve your space at the camp of your choice. Apply online, or download the application from the ADA website: www.diabetes.org
2. Contact me to receive your Cup For Camp. Take it around and pre-sell the coffee cups to your relatives, friends, and neighbors.
3. Collect the money by May 1st.
4. No later than **May 15th**, send in payment and your Order Form (below)
5. Upon receipt of your order, arrangement will be made to deliver your cups and check (made out to ADA).
6. Distribute cups to all your *Proud Supporters*.
7. Send in your check and other necessary paperwork to the American Diabetes Association.
8. Have fun at camp!

You must complete the camp application process and satisfy all necessary ADA camp requirements with your camp.
